ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 65 of the Films Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Minister of Internal Affairs after that Minister had conferred, as required by subsection (2) of that section, with representatives of the film industry, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Films (Drive-in Cinemas) Order 1986.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1986.
- 2. End of prohibition on exhibition of films in drive-in cinemas—For the purposes of section 65 (1) of the Films Act 1983, the

earliest date on which any person may exhibit any film in a drive-in cinema is hereby fixed as the 1st day of December 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 December 1986, ends the prohibition on the exhibition of films in drive-in cinemas.
