ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 1st day of April 1975

Present:

THE HON. R. J. TIZARD PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Factories Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metrication—(1) Regulation 23 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "250 cu. ft." and substituting the expression "7 cubic metres".

(2) Regulation 23 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting, wherever it appears, the expression "400 cu. ft." and substituting in each case the expression "12 cubic metres".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations substitute 7 cubic metres for 250 cu. ft., and 12 cubic metres for 400 cu. ft., as the space required to be reserved per person in a factory by day and night respectively.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 3 April 1975.
