AMENDMENT NO. 6**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of August 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Factories Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1977.

2. Fee for outworker's licence—Regulation 22 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the expression "25c" (as substituted by section 7 of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) and substituting the expression "\$1".

3. Factory registration fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the Third Schedule thereto (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule hereto.

(2) The Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 3 are hereby consequentially revoked.

Where maximum number of persons employed in factory exceeds 50	\$35
In all other cases	\$10"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase fees payable under the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937. The fee for an outworker's licence is increased from 25c to \$1. The fee for the registration of a factory is also increased. The old fee varied according to the number of employees in the factory and was:

51 to 100 employees	15	00
11 to 50 employees	7	50
6 to 10 employees	3	00
5 or fewer employees	1	50
The new fee is:						
Over 50 employees	35	00
50 or fewer employees	10	00.
