ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of August 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Factories Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1979.

2. Factory registration fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule thereto (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6), and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6 is hereby consequentially revoked.

More than 50 and fewer than 251	50
More than 250	100"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 February 1979, increase the registration fee payable in respect of a factory. Both the old and the new fee vary according to the number of persons employed in the factory concerned.

The old fee was:	\$
Up to 50 employees	10
Over 50 employees	35
The new fee is:	
Up to 20 employees	10
21 to 50 employees	25
51 to 250 employees	50
Over 250 employees	100
