**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of August 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Factories Act 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1982.

**2. Fee for outworker's licence**—Regulation 22 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$2" (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the expression "\$3".

**3. Factory registration fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Factories Consolidating Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase certain fees payable in respect of factories. As from 1 February 1982, the fee for an outworker's licence is increased from \$2 to \$3; and registration fees for factories are increased as follows: factories with fewer than 21 workers, from \$13 to \$16; from 21 to 50 workers, from \$32 to \$39; from 51 to 250 workers, from \$63 to \$76; more than 250 workers, from \$125 to \$150.
