PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (West Coast Whitebait Fishing) Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (West Coast Whitebait Fishing) Regulations 1985* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to the definition of the term “licensed structure” the words “; and includes any structure so used that is approved under section 178 of that Act”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*, extend the meaning of the term "licensed structure" to include structures situated on private land and approved under section 178 of the Harbours Act 1950. The extension has the effect of allowing whitebait fishing from such structures.
