HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Butterfat levy for farm-dairy instruction—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the words "at the rate of 0.0362d.", and substituting the words "at the rate of 0.0301c".
- 3. Revocation—The Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 4, are hereby consequentially revoked.
