THE FRUIT-EXPORT CONTROL BOARD ELECTION REGULATIONS, 1925, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Fruit Control

Act, 1924.

Date on which the regulations were made: 5th day of March, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 11th day of March, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Fruit-export Control Board Election Regulations, 1925, Amendment No. 1.

(2) These regulations shall be read together with and be deemed to form part of the Fruit-export Control Board Election Regulations, 1925* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

(3) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1937.

2. For the purposes of the election to be held in the year 1937 by the producers in the Provincial Districts of Hawke's Bay and Wellington of a person for appointment by the Governor-General to fill the vacancy occurring in the office of a producers' representative on the Board in that year, the following special provisions shall, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the principal regulations, apply:—

(a) The roll of producers for the said provincial districts shall be deposited in the Head Office of the Department of Agricul-

ture not later than the 5th day of August;

(b) The last day and hour for receiving nominations shall be the 12th day of August at noon; and

- (c) Any poll to be taken in that year shall close at noon on the 31st day of August, 1937.
- 3. Except as varied by clause 2 of these regulations, all the other provisions of the principal regulations shall apply to the election to which these regulations apply.
