**THE FLOUR EXTRACTION CONTROL NOTICE 1946**

PURSUANT to the Wheat and Flour Emergency Regulations 1939, the Wheat and Flour Controller hereby directs and gives notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Flour Extraction Control Notice 1946.

2. This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of May, 1946.

3. In this notice—

“Consent” means the prior written consent of the Wheat and Flour Controller or of some person authorized by him in that behalf :

“Flourmiller” means a person carrying on the business of milling wheat into flour, and includes every person for the time being having the actual control or management of a flourmill.

4. No flourmiller shall without consent at any time after the coming into force of this notice so conduct the milling of wheat into flour that less than 80 per cent. by weight of the wheat is converted into flour or so that less than 80 per cent. by weight of the products from milling operations are extracted as flour.

5. No flourmiller shall without consent at any time be in possession of flour manufactured after the coming into force of this notice which contains less than 80 per cent. by weight of the products derived from the milling of wheat.

6. Any consent given pursuant to this notice shall be subject to the provisions of clause (3) of Regulation 6 of the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939.\*
