PURSUANT to section 30 (6) (b) of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Lake Ellesmere Eel Fishery) Decontrolling Order 1997.
 - (2) This order comes into force on 1 February 1998.
- 2. Lake Ellesmere eel fishery to cease to be controlled fishery—It is declared that the Lake Ellesmere eel fishery ceases to be a controlled fishery on and from 1 February 1998.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides that the Lake Ellesmere eel fishery will cease to be a controlled fishery on 1 February 1998. From that date it will become subject to an individual quota management regime (see the Fisheries (Lake Ellesmere Eel Quota) Regulations 1997).
