PURSUANT to section 30 (6) (b) of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Lake Ellesmere Eel Fishery) Decontrolling Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on 1 February 1998.

**2. Lake Ellesmere eel fishery to cease to be controlled fishery**—It is declared that the Lake Ellesmere eel fishery ceases to be a controlled fishery on and from 1 February 1998.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order provides that the Lake Ellesmere eel fishery will cease to be a controlled fishery on 1 February 1998. From that date it will become subject to an individual quota management regime (*see* the Fisheries (Lake Ellesmere Eel Quota) Regulations 1997).
