ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of May 1985

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Forestry Encouragement Grants Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forestry Encouragement Grants Regulations 1983\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Closing date for production grants for other claimants**—Regulation 13B (b) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Forestry

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations extend the closing date for claims for production grants for claimants other than local authorities and Maori Authorities to those furnished to the Conservator on or before 19 December 1985. The claims were formerly to be received by the Conservator on or before 31 January 1985.
