

THE FORESTRY ENCOURAGEMENT LOANS REGULATIONS 1967, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to the Forestry Encouragement Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Forestry Encouragement Loans Regulations 1967, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Forestry Encouragement Loans Regulations 1967* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Amendment to First Schedule—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Part A.
- 3. Savings—Notwithstanding anything in these regulations, any application under the principal regulations by an applicant other than a local authority shall, if received before the 31st day of August 1969 by the Conservator whose conservancy includes the proposed loan area, be eligible in accordance with the terms and conditions of the principal regulations in every way as if these regulations had not been made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Forestry Encouragement Loans Regulations 1967. Persons other than local authorities are no longer eligible for forestry encouragement loans.
