# THE FINANCE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 12

COBHAM, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

#### At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of July 1960

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Finance Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Finance Emergency Regulations 1940 (No. 2)\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to paragraph (a) of subclause (1) the following proviso:

"Provided that an authorised officer may, in his discretion, relieve the traveller of his obligation to make and deliver such a declaration, and may (if he thinks fit) require the traveller to make an oral declaration instead thereof."

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting, from the heading to regulation 4, the words "by Travellers", and substituting the words "Sent or Transferred from New Zealand".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 4 (1) of the principal regulations provides that every person over 16 who is about to leave New Zealand shall make and deliver a written declaration as to whether or not he is taking with him any money or securities. These regulations provide that an authorised officer may, in his discretion, relieve the traveller of his obligation to make and deliver such a declaration, and may (if he thinks fit) require the traveller to make an oral declaration instead thereof.
