THE FINANCE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940. AMENDMENT NO. 6

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of August, 1948

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Finance Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Finance Emergency Regulations 1940 (No. 2)* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term "gold" in subclause (1), and

substituting the following definition:-

- "'Gold' includes gold, gold coin, gold bullion, retorted gold, gold-ores, gold-amalgam, gold-alloys, precipitates containing gold, slag, concentrates, tailings, and residues; but, with the exception of gold coin, does not include things manufactured of gold:"
- 3. The heading to Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words "Coin and Bullion."
- 4. Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words "Coin and Bullion" in the reference to Regulation 5.
