## THE FISHING-BOATS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of July, 1942.

## Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Fishing-boats Emergency Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fishing-boats Emergency Regulations 1941\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) all words after the words "for the purpose of", and substituting the words "controlling the movements of fishing-boats, and, in particular, for all or any of the following purposes:—

"(a) Preventing or prohibiting fishing-boats from being in, going to, or leaving any specified place or class of places, or any place except a specified place or class of places:

- "(b) Preventing or prohibiting fishing-boats from moving at specified times or in specified circumstances, or at any time or under any circumstances except specified times or circumstances:
- "(c) Requiring fishing-boats to be based on or operated from specified ports or places or classes thereof."

- 3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Regulation 6, and substituting the following regulation:—
- "6. (1) Whenever any fishing-boat proceeds on any voyage, whether within or beyond the limits of any port, the master shall report to such authorized officer or other person as the Minister may appoint in that behalf before the boat commences the voyage and also immediately after completing the voyage.
- "(2) The master or owner of any fishing-boat shall not cause or permit it to be used for any purpose other than fishing for purposes of sale."
