



**FISHERIES (CONVERSION FACTORS) AMENDMENT NOTICE
1997**

PURSUANT to section 3A (2) of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries, acting after consultation with the Fishing Industry Board, gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Conversion Factors) Amendment Notice 1997, and is part of the Fisheries (Conversion Factors) Notice 1996* (“the principal notice”).

(2) This notice comes into force on 1 October 1997.

2. Conversion factors for barracouta, hoki, and ling—(1) Part I of the Schedule of the principal notice is amended—

(a) By omitting from the column headed “Dressed”, in respect of the item relating to barracouta (BAR), the expression “1.50”, and substituting the expression “1.55”:

(b) By omitting from the same column, in respect of the item relating to ling (LIN), the expression “1.80”, and substituting the expression “1.85”.

(2) Part II of the Schedule of the principal notice is amended by omitting from clause 5 the expression “2.05”, and substituting the expression “2.15”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 1 October 1997, amends the Fisheries (Conversion Factors) Notice 1996 by changing some of the conversion factors for barracouta, hoki, and ling.

The changes are as follows:

- (a) The conversion factor for dressed barracouta is increased from 1.50 to 1.55;
- (b) The conversion factor for dressed ling is increased from 1.80 to 1.85;
- (c) The conversion factor for skin-on untrimmed fillets for hoki is increased from 2.05 to 2.15.
