PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983 and sections 297 and 298 of the Fisheries Act 1996, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 1997, and are part of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986* ("the principal regulations").
 - (2) These regulations come into force on 1 April 1997.

- 2. Second Schedule amended—Clause 7 of Part IV of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 (1) of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 23) is amended by revoking subclause (4), and substituting the following subclause:
- "(4) The fee payable in respect of the notification under section 67M of the Act of a transfer of an interest in a marine farming permit is \$225.00."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1997, amend the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, which deals with fees, by correcting a misdescription in a reference to applications made under section 67M of the Fisheries Act 1983. The reference should in fact be to notifications made under that section, which provides that the transfer of an interest in a marine farming permit has no effect until notified to the chief executive of the Ministry of Fisheries.
