

# FISHERIES (COMMERCIAL FISHING) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS (NO. 2) 1997

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983 and sections 297 and 298 of the Fisheries Act 1996, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 1997, and are part of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986\* ("the principal regulations").
  - (2) These regulations come into force on 1 October 1997.

- 2. Fees—(1) Part I of the Second Schedule of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 23) is amended by revoking paragraph (d) of clause 2, and substituting the following paragraph:
  - "(d) Application for special permit under section 64 of the Act (including subsequent issue of the permit):

    "(i) If the time taken to process the application does not exceed 4 hours ... ...

    "(ii) In any other case, for each hour or part hour taken to process the application (including the first 4 hours) ...

- (2) Part I of the Second Schedule of the principal regulations (as so substituted) is amended by revoking paragraph (f), and substituting the following paragraph:
  - "(f) Amendment or alteration to conditions of permit at request of permit holder:
    - "(i) In the case of a special permit under section 64 of the Act, for each hour or part hour taken to process the application ... ... 77.13 per hour or part hour

- "(ii) In any other case ... ... 15.00"
- (3) Part IV of the Second Schedule of the principal regulations (as so substituted and as amended by regulation 2 of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 1997) is amended by revoking clauses 7 and 8, and substituting the following clauses:
- "7. Marine farming permits and spat catching permits—(1) The fee payable in respect of an application for a marine farming permit under section 67J of the Act is \$1,530.00.
- "(2) The fee payable in respect of an application for a spat catching permit under section 67Q of the Act is \$1,530.00.
- "(3) The fee payable in respect of an application by the holder of a marine farming permit or a spat catching permit for a change to the conditions of that permit under section 67k of the Act is \$967.50.
- "(4) The fee payable in respect of the notification under section 67M of the Act of a transfer of an interest in a marine farming permit is \$607.50.
- "8. Inspection of marine farming register—The fee payable in respect of any inspection of the register of marine farming permits that is kept under section 671 (12) of the Act is \$123.75."
- **3. Revocation**—The Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Amendment Regulations 1997 (S.R. 1997/26) are revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1997, alter the fees payable in relation to—

- (a) Applications for special permits under section 64 of the Fisheries Act 1983, and for alteration of the conditions of such permits; and
- (b) Marine farming permits and spat catching permits. Some fees are increased and others decreased.
