THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES (NORTH CANTERBURY) REGULATIONS MODIFICATION NOTICE 1950

Marine Department, Wellington, 18th September, 1950.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, and the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1936, the Minister of Marine hereby gives notice as follows.

NOTICE

- 1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries (North Canterbury) Regulations Modification Notice 1950.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. The Freshwater Fisheries (North Canterbury) Regulations 1946* (hereinafter referred to as the said regulations) are hereby modified as follows:—
 - (a) Notwithstanding anything contained in regulation 14 of the said regulations (as substituted by regulation 10 of the Freshwater Fisheries (North Canterbury) Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 1) no person shall fish for trout or other acclimatized fish in any of the high-country waters, other than Lakes Coleridge, Katrine, Sheppard, Sumner, and Taylor, with any lure or bait other than artificial fly or feather lure.
 - (b) Notwithstanding anything contained in regulation 15 of the said regulations (as substituted by regulation 11 of the Freshwater Fisheries (North Canterbury) Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 1) no person shall in fishing for trout or other acclimatized fish in any of the high-country waters, other than Lakes Coleridge, Katrine, Sheppard, Sumner, and Taylor, use a weighted line or cast or use an artificial fly or feather lure in the making of which lead or other weight has been incorporated to facilitate the casting or sinking of that artificial fly or feather lure."
