



**THE FISH (PACKING FOR EXPORT) REGULATIONS 1977,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Meat Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fish (Packing for Export) Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fish (Packing for Export) Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1978.

2. Inspection fees and returns—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulations 85 and 86, and the Schedule.

(2) Regulation 90 (4) of the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the expression "86."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations so as to abolish inspection fees, and to revoke the obligation on licensees to file quarterly returns as to the weight of fish processed and packaged.

The amendment will come into force on 1 October 1978.
