



**THE FISH (PACKING FOR EXPORT) REGULATIONS  
MODIFICATION NOTICE 1982**

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PURSUANT to regulation 35 (2) (a) (v) of the Fish (Packing for Export) Regulations 1977 (as added by regulation 10 (2) of the Fish (Packing for Export) Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 2), the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

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**NOTICE**

**1. Title, interpretation, and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fish (Packing for Export) Regulations Modification Notice 1982, and shall be interpreted as if it were part of the Fish (Packing for Export) Regulations 1977\* (hereinafter referred to as the regulations).  
(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1983.

**2. Fish to be frozen or chilled before delivered to fish packing house**—For the purposes of regulation 35 of the regulations, no fish shall be accepted into a fish packing house for processing or packaging if it is apparent, or should be apparent to a person exercising reasonable care in the circumstances, that the fish have not been held in a frozen or chilled state between the time they were caught and the time of delivery to the fish packing house.
