

THE FISHERIES (CONVERSION FACTORS) NOTICE 1990, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to section 3a (2) of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries, acting after consultation with the Fishing Industry Board, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Conversion Factors) Notice 1990, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Conversion Factors) Notice 1990* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- **2. Interpretation**—Clause 2 of the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting from the definition of the term "headed and gutted" the words "whether or not the pectoral fin has been removed,".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice amends the Fisheries (Conversion Factors) Notice 1990 to remove from the definition of the term "headed and gutted" the words "whether or not the pectoral fin has been removed." At best the words are redundant, and at worst confusing.
