THE FRESH-WATER FISHERIES (OTAGO) REGULATIONS, 1936.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Fisheries
Act, 1908.

Date on which the regulations were made: 7th day of October, 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 8th day of October, 1936.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Fresh-water Fisheries (Otago) Regulations, 1936.
- 2. These regulations shall apply only within the Otago Acclimatization District and the waters thereof.
- 3. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of first, the regulations for the Otago Acclimatization District and the waters thereof made on the 19th day of September, 1932,* and, secondly, the Trout-fishing (Otago) Regulations, 1936.†
- 4. Regulation 4 of the Trout-fishing (Otago) Regulations, 1936, is revoked.
- 5. No person shall use in fishing for eels in the district any hook that is smaller than 4/0, nor shall such person use any gut or gut substitute attached to the hook:

Provided that this regulation shall not apply on any river within a mile of the sea by water from low-tide mark.
