**THE FRESH-WATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS, 1936,
AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Fisheries Act,
1908.

Date on which the regulations were made : 23rd day of June, 1937.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 1st day of July, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fresh-water Fisheries Regulations, 1936, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Fresh-water Fisheries Regulations, 1936* (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").

3. Regulation 44 of the principal regulations is amended by prefixing thereto the following words :—

" Subject to any local regulations permitting the use of worm as a bait or lure."

4. Regulation 45 of the principal regulations is amended by adding thereto the following words :—

" Other than a preparation to ensure buoyancy of the line in dry fly fishing."

5. Regulation 48 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following proviso :—

" Provided that nothing in this regulation shall affect the validity of any local regulations prohibiting the taking of trout exceeding a greater length than 9 in."

6. Regulation 57 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words and figures " Part VII ", and substituting the words and figures " Part VIII ".

7. Regulation 77 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the figures " 74 ", and substituting the figures " 71 ".

8. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words and figures " 27th July ", and substituting the words and figures " 29th July ".
