## THE FRESH-WATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS, 1936, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Fisheries Act,
1908.

Date on which the regulations were made: 23rd day of June, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 1st day of July, 1937.

## REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Fresh-water Fisheries Regulations, 1936, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Fresh-water Fisheries Regulations, 1936\* (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").
- 3. Regulation 44 of the principal regulations is amended by prefixing thereto the following words:—
- "Subject to any local regulations permitting the use of worm as a bait or lure."
- 4. Regulation 45 of the principal regulations is amended by adding thereto the following words:—
- "Other than a preparation to ensure buoyancy of the line in dry fly fishing."
- 5. Regulation 48 of the principal regulations is amended by adding the following proviso:—
- "Provided that nothing in this regulation shall affect the validity of any local regulations prohibiting the taking of trout exceeding a greater length than 9 in."
- **6.** Regulation 57 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words and figures "Part VIII", and substituting the words and figures "Part VIII".
- 7. Regulation 77 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the figures "74", and substituting the figures "71".
- 8. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words and figures "27th July", and substituting the words and figures "29th July".
