THE FRESH-WATER FISHERIES (SOUTHLAND) REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 3.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 21st day of August, 1940.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fresh-water Fisheries (Southland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 3.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Fresh-water Fisheries (Southland) Regulations 1937 and the amendments thereof.*

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1940.

4. Regulation 7 of the Fresh-water Fisheries (Southland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2, is amended by adding the following paragraph thereto.

"(d) That portion of Lake Te Anau within half a mile of the water's edge, commencing at a point half a mile to the west of the mouth of the Clinton River and extending along the eastern and then the southern side of the lake to a point half a mile to the west of the outlet (the Waiau River)."
