**THE FRESH-WATER FISHERIES (SOUTHLAND)
REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 4.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 20th day of
November, 1940.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fresh-water Fisheries (Southland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Fresh-water Fisheries (Southland) Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1940.

4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting therein next after Regulation 13 thereof the following additional regulation :—

“ 13A. No person shall in fishing for any acclimatized fish in that portion of the Upokororo River from its source down to the road bridge use any bait or lure other than artificial fly.”

5. The principal regulations are amended by inserting therein next after Regulation 14 thereof the following additional regulation :—

“ 14A. No person shall on any one day take or kill from that portion of the Upokororo River from its source down to the road bridge more than three Atlantic salmon or continue to fish for Atlantic salmon in that portion of the Upokororo River from its source down to the road bridge on any day on which he had already taken or killed three Atlantic salmon therein.”

6. Regulation 6 of the Fresh-water Fisheries (Southland) Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2, is amended by adding after the words "Upokororo River" the following proviso:—

"Provided that it shall be lawful for any person to fish for acclimatized fish in that part of the Upokororo River from its source down to the road bridge from the 1st day of December in each year to the 28th day of February (both days inclusive) in the following year."
