PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1977.

**2. Increased licence fees in South Island**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 13), and substituting the new First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 4 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 13†, and the First Schedule to those regulations are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951. The effect is to institute a new higher scale of licence fees for licences issued in the South Island than for licences issued in the North Island as from 1 January 1977.
