ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 48 and 48A of the Conservation Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title, commencement, and application**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Except as provided in subclause (3) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1991, and shall apply in respect of licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after that day.

(3) The new licence fees set out in Table 2 of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of these regulations) shall apply in respect of licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after the 1st day of July 1991.

**2. Area of availability of licences**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 6 (as amended by regulation 4 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 9), and substituting the following regulation:

“6. (1) A whole season licence and a weekly licence shall be available throughout New Zealand, unless it is issued only for the Eastern Fish and Game Region or the Taupo District; and a licence issued for that region or district shall be available only in respect of that region or district.

“(2) A monthly licence shall be available only in respect of the Eastern Fish and Game Region.

“(3) A day licence shall be available only in respect of the region for which it is issued.”

(2) Regulation 4 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 9 is hereby consequentially revoked.

**3. New Schedule of licence fees substituted**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 (1) of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 8 is hereby consequentially revoked.

## LICENCES AND FEES

1. *Fees for general licence:* Whole season licences and weekly licences are available throughout New Zealand, unless issued only for the Eastern Fish and Game Region or the Taupo District. Monthly licences are available only in the Eastern Fish and Game Region. Day licences are available only in the region of issue.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which amend the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983,—

- (a) Clarify the provisions relating to the availability of licences; and
- (b) Increase the fees payable in respect of adult licences issued under the principal regulations.

The new fees in respect of the Eastern Fish and Game Region take effect on 1 July 1991, and the other amendments take effect on 1 October 1991.
