PURSUANT to sections 48 and 48A of the Conservation Act 1987, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1992, and shall apply in respect of licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after that day.

1. Fees for general licence: Whole season licences and weekly licences are available throughout New Zealand, except in the Eastern Fish and Game Region or the Taupo District. Monthly licences are available only in the Eastern Fish and Game Region. Day licences are available only in the region of issue.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1992, amend the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983 by increasing all the fishing licence fees for the Eastern Fish and Game Region except the fee for the adult weekly licence. The range of increases is from \$1.50 to \$6, and the adult weekly licence fee is reduced by \$1.
