PURSUANT to sections 48 and 48A of the Conservation Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 13, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1992, and shall apply in respect of licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after that day.
- 2. New Second Schedule substituted—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 12), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

1. Fees for general licence: Whole season licences and weekly licences are available throughout New Zealand, except in the Eastern Fish and Game Region or the Taupo District. Monthly licences are available only in the Eastern Fish and Game Region. Day licences are available only in the region of issue.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1992, increase general licence fees prescribed by the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983 as follows:

- (a) The adult whole licence fee is increased by \$3:
- (b) The adult weekly licence is increased by \$1: (c) The adult daily licence is increased by \$2.50:
- (d) The junior whole season licence is increased by 50 cents.

 The fees applying in the Eastern Fish and Game Region are not changed by these regulations.
