



**THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS 1983,
AMENDMENT NO. 16**

PURSUANT to sections 48 and 48A of the Conservation Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 16, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1994.

2. New fees and licences for Eastern Fish and Game Region—

(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Part III of the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 15), and substituting the Part III set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The winter season licences referred to in Section B of Part III of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by subclause (1) of this regulation) shall be valid only in respect of the period commencing on the 1st day of July in any year and ending with the close of the 30th day of September in that year, and the fees in respect of such licences shall be payable only in respect of that period.

(3) The combined winter and open season licence referred to in Part III of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations (as so substituted) shall be valid only in respect of the period commencing on the 1st day of July 1994 and ending with the close of the 30th day of September 1995, and the fees in respect of such licences shall be payable only in respect of that period.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1994, amend the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983 by introducing some new licence fees and increasing some existing licence fees. The amendments affect only the Eastern Fish and Game Region.

The changes are as follows:

- (a) The adult whole season licence is increased from \$55 to \$56:
- (b) The adult month licence is increased from \$37 to \$37.50:
- (c) The adult week licence is increased from \$22 to \$22.50:
- (d) A new adult winter licence is introduced for the period 1 July in any year to 30 September in the same year at a fee of \$13:
- (e) A new child winter licence is introduced for the period 1 July in any year to 30 September in the same year at a fee of \$2.50:
- (f) A new adult combined winter and open season licence is introduced for the period 1 July 1994 to 30 September 1995 at a fee of \$69:
- (g) A new child combined winter and open season licence is introduced for the period 1 July 1994 to 30 September 1995 at a fee of \$14.
