HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1985.

2. Increase in licence fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 6 (1) of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 6 of, and the Schedule to, the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.
