ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1988.

2. Licence fees—(1) Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the words “(which fees are inclusive of goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985)”.

(2) Regulation 14A of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 5) is hereby revoked.

(3) Regulation 17 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "aggregate fees", the words "(after deduction of goods and services tax)".

3. Increase in licence fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 5), and substituting the new Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

4. Revocation—The Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 5 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1988, increase the fees for general licences and for Southern Lakes District licences.

The fees are now GST inclusive.
