

# THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS 1983, AMENDMENT NO. 7

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 29th day of May 1989

#### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. G. W. R. PALMER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall apply in respect of all licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after the 1st day of July 1989.
- 2. Increase in licence fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 6), and

**3. Revocation**—Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 6 are hereby consequentially revoked.

# EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which apply from 1 July 1989, increase most fees for general acclimatisation licences and for Rotorua District and Southern Lakes District licences. In relation to the Rotorua District, the increases range from 20 cents for a junior day licence to \$6 for an adult whole season licence. For all other districts the increases range between 50 cents and \$1, with the junior day licence remaining at \$2.50.
