**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 15th day of September 1986

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1986.

**2. Trawling by vessels over 43 m long prohibited in territorial sea**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 47, the following regulation:

“47A. No commercial fisherman shall use any New Zealand fishing vessel over 43 m in overall length for trawling in the territorial sea.”

**3. Offences**—Regulation 57 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the expression “47,”, the expression “47A,”.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations insert in the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations 1986 a prohibition on trawling in the territorial sea by vessels over 43 m in length that was formerly in the Fisheries (1985–86 Commercial Quotas and Restrictions) Regulations 1986.
