



**THE FISHERIES (AMATEUR FISHING) REGULATIONS 1986,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

PURSUANT to section 89 of the Fisheries Act 1983, section 48A of the Conservation Act 1987, and to section 40(1) of the Conservation Law Reform Act 1990, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms “whitebait” and “whitebait net”.

3. Revocation—Regulation 16 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, revoke the provisions of the Fisheries (Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1986 that relate to whitebait fishing. Those provisions are now contained in the Whitebait Fishing Regulations 1991.
