## THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS (NORTH CANTERBURY) MODIFICATION NOTICE 1975, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to the Fisheries Act 1908 and the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

- 1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (North Canterbury) Modification Notice 1975, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (North Canterbury) Modification Notice 1975\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- 2. Commencement—This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 3. Application—This notice shall be in force only within the North Canterbury Acclimatisation District.
- 4. Open Season Exceptions—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking subparagraph (ii) of clause 5 (d), and substituting the following subparagraph:
  - "(ii) During the period commencing on the 1st day of October in any year and ending with the Friday immediately preceding the first Saturday in November in that year for acclimatised fish in any high country waters:".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect. The effect of the notice is to prohibit fishing for acclimatised fish in Lakes Taylor, Sumner, Coleridge, Lyndon, and Selfe, and all other high country waters (as defined in the principal notice), during the period expressed in clause 4 of the notice.
