



**THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS (NORTH
CANTERBURY) MODIFICATION NOTICE 1978, AMENDMENT
NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 83 (2) (d) of the Fisheries Act 1908 and to regulation 7 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (North Canterbury) Modification Notice 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (North Canterbury) Modification Notice 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Commencement—This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1979.

3. Restrictions on lures and methods—Clause 5 (c) of the principal notice is hereby amended by adding the following subparagraph:

“(iv) Use artificial minnow in the Kaiapoi River and its tributaries upstream of the Williams Street Bridge:”.

4. Open season exceptions—(1) Clause 5 (d) of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking subparagraph (iv) (5).

(2) The said clause 5 (d) is hereby further amended by adding the following subparagraph:

“(v) During the months of February, March, and April, nor take during those months, quinnat salmon in the Kaiapoi and Cam Rivers or any tributary of those rivers, upstream of the Williams Street Bridge:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice imposes additional restrictions on fishing in the Kaiapoi and Cam Rivers.
