THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES (SOUTHLAND) REGULATIONS MODIFICATION NOTICE 1950

Marine Department, Wellington, 27th October, 1950.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, and the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1936, the Minister of Marine hereby gives notice as follows.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries (Southland) Regulations Modification Notice 1950.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Freshwater Fisheries (Southland) Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the said regulations) are hereby modified as follows :---

Notwithstanding any provision of the said regulations, no person shall fish for, take, or kill any acclimatized fish in any waters of the Mataura River between a straight line drawn across the said river from a point on the east bank in line with the northern boundary of Eden Street in the Borough of Mataura and a straight line drawn across the said river from a point on the east bank in line with the northern boundary of Doctor's Road in the said borough; the limits of the said waters being more specifically shown by white posts marked "Prohibited fishing limit" and erected on the banks of the said river at the terminal points of the lines hereinbefore described.
