



**THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS
(ASHBURTON) MODIFICATION NOTICE 1978,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 83 (2) (d) of the Fisheries Act 1908, and to regulation 7 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (Ashburton) Modification Notice 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (Ashburton) Modification Notice 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Commencement—This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3. Restrictions on methods of fishing—(1) Clause 4 (c) of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the proviso to subparagraph (ii), and substituting the following proviso:

“Provided that a person may fish from a securely anchored boat in—

“(a) The Maori Lakes, Lake Emma, and Lake Heron:

“(b) Lake Clearwater (also known as Tripp) at a distance of at least 70 m from any bank or island.”

(2) Clause 4 (c) (iv) of the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the word “source”, and substituting the word “mouth”.
