



**THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES REGULATIONS (HAWERA,  
STRATFORD, AND TARANAKI) MODIFICATION NOTICE  
1975, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 83 (2) (d) of the Fisheries Act 1908, and to regulation 7 of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951, the Minister of Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

---

**NOTICE**

**1. Title**—This notice may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (Hawera, Stratford, and Taranaki) Modification Notice 1975, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations (Hawera, Stratford, and Taranaki) Modification Notice 1975\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

**2. Commencement**—This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**3. Open season exception**—Clause 4 of the principal notice is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (e), the following heading and paragraph:

*“Open Season Exception*

“(f) No person shall fish for acclimatised fish at any time in that part of the Patea River or its tributaries which lie upstream of the hydro-dam site on the river to the boundary of the Hawera Acclimatisation District.”

The notice closes the Patea River to fishing above the site of the dam being built on it.
