**THE FOOD HYGIENE REGULATIONS 1952,
AMENDMENT No. 1**

PURSUANT to the Health Act 1920 and the Food and Drugs Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Food Hygiene Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Food Hygiene Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "or, in the absence of such by-laws", and substituting the words "or, in the absence of such registration".

3. Regulation 34 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

4. Regulation 60 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

Regulation 2 of these regulations clarifies regulation 10 of the principal regulations, which prohibits the use of certain types of food premises unless they are registered by a local authority, or, in certain circumstances, unless the permission of a Medical Officer of Health is obtained. The circumstances in which the permission of a Medical Officer of Health is required are the absence of a local authority or the absence of a registration procedure operated by the local authority.

Regulation 3 revokes the provision in the principal regulations requiring the wrapping of bread sold by retail.

Regulation 4 revokes the prohibition on the sale of unpacked ice cream in shops where vegetables and certain other goods are sold.
