## Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Dairy Industry Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1938\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following

notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

- **4.** Paragraph (b) of clause (1) of Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "August, September, and October", and substituting the words "October, November, and December".
- 5. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words "August," "September," and "October" wherever they occur, and substituting the words "October," "November," and "December" respectively.
- 6. The form in the Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words and figures "maximum number of suppliers during period 1st August to 31st October, 19..", and substituting the words and figures "maximum number of suppliers during period 1st October to 31st December, 19..".
