THE FARM-DAIRY INSTRUCTION REGULATIONS 1949,  
AMENDMENT NO. 10

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Farm-Dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1977.

**2. Butterfat levy for farm-dairy instruction**—Regulation 5 (a) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “at the rate of 0.318c per kilogram” (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 9), and substituting the words “at the rate of 0.3622c per kilogram”.

**3. Revocation**—The Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 9 are hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase the levy on butterfat for farm-dairy instruction from 0.318c per kilogram to 0.3622c per kilogram from 1 June 1977.
