

THE FARM-DAIRY INSTRUCTION REGULATIONS 1949, AMENDMENT NO. 9

Pursuant to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1976.
- 2. Butterfat levy for farm-dairy instruction—Regulation 5 (a) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "at the rate of 0.1687c per kilogram" (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 8), and substituting the words "at the rate of 0.318c per kilogram".
- 3. Revocation—The Farm-dairy Instruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 8 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the levy on butterfat for farm-dairy instruction from 0.1687c per kilogram to 0.318c per kilogram.
