ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 15th day of December 1997

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 175 of the Fisheries Act 1996, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Fisheries, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Waikare Inlet Taiapure) Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Waikare Inlet taiapure constituted—The New Zealand fisheries waters (being estuarine or littoral coastal waters) described in the Schedule are declared to be a taiapure-local fishery.

SCHEDULE
WAIKARE INLET TAIAPURE

All that area of New Zealand fisheries waters enclosed by a line commencing at Tapu Point (at $35^{\circ} 18.62' S$, $174^{\circ} 7.43' E$), then proceeding in a south-easterly direction along a line to Motutokape Island (at $35^{\circ} 18.97' S$, $174^{\circ} 7.95' E$), then to a point on the mainland (at $35^{\circ} 19.0' S$, $174^{\circ} 07.7' E$), then proceeding along the line of the mean high water mark including Kaurinui and Waikino Creeks and the Waikare Inlet back to the point of commencement.
