**THE FISHERIES (ROCK LOBSTER TOTAL ALLOWABLE
COMMERCIAL CATCH) ORDER 1993**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE HON. DOUG KIDD PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 280C of the Fisheries Act 1983, Her Excellency the Governor-General, on the recommendation of the Minister of Fisheries made in accordance with section 28D of that Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Commercial Catch) Order 1993.
(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1993.

2. Reduction in total allowable commercial catch—The Maori Fisheries Act 1989 is hereby amended by repealing the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Commercial Catch) Order 1992), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to this order.

3. Revocation—The Fisheries (Rock Lobster Total Allowable Commercial Catch) Order 1992 (S.R. 1992/23) is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 April 1993, fixes the total allowable commercial catch for spiny rock lobster in the various quota management areas and fixes the total allowable commercial catch for packhorse rock lobster in all New Zealand fisheries waters.
