THE FISHERIES (QUOTA MANAGEMENT AREAS, TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCHES, AND CATCH HISTORIES) NOTICE 1986, AMENDMENT NO. 2

PURSUANT to section 28C of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries, acting after allowing for the matters specified in that section, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 24th day of July 1987.

2. Total allowable catch for hake increased—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting the item relating to hake, and substituting the following item:

“Hake (<i>Merluccius australis</i>)	A. Auckland (East), Auckland (West), Central (East), Central (Egmont), South-East (Coast), Southland, and Sub-Antarctic combined	1,2,3,5,6, 8, & 9	2 500

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice (which comes into force on 24 July 1987) amends the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches, and Catch Histories) Notice 1986.

The notice increases the total allowable catch for hake in the Challenger/Central (Plateau) Quota Management Area from 1100 to 3000 tonnes.
